### **BRaid Managers report April 2021**

#### **Braided River Partnership Project:**

- Lotteries funding for this specific project ends this year at which time it will be rolled into general business
- Contact maintained regularly with interested parties through social media, newsletters
- Meeting with possible Opihi River group (see below)
- Aspiring Biodiversity Trust has requested bronze accreditation to Wilkin Jets be upgraded to Silver; I have requested supporting evidence

# Funding

- Application to RCEES for 2021 Seminar part costs applied for and approved (the budget is a function of catering, which is a function of the final number of attendees, so an exact figure won't be available until a few days before the event).
- Funding from ECan for climate resiliency project approved: \$15,000.00
- End-project Lotteries 'Partnership Project' report due at the end of this year
- Mid-year funding from ECan report due in June
- Application to Lotteries for further funding declined: we've had this for 6 years, which is twice the original time, so all in all a good outcome

### Education/outreach/support

- Three newsletters have been sent since the last meeting, delivered to 250 verified emails. Newsletters are archived here: <u>https://braidedrivers.org/news/</u>. These newsletters compile all the research and reports that come in, so a quick check of the last few newsletters will bring you up to date.
- **BRaid Website**: Ongoing attempts to hack the site requires regular attention. All plugins and software are up-to-date and the site is backed up daily. A screen grab of site stats for March 2021 is below. Search engines are the primary source of referrals.
- **Climate website** (now funded by ECan) <u>https://climateandnature.org.nz</u> : 70 pages now completed; around 18 in development (not visible). A technical working group will assess the KPIs. By design this site aims to foster and share the who, what, when, where, why, and how ecosystem protection and restoration as fundamental to our response to climate change. The more people who can contribute, the better.
- Member's area on the BRaid website: is no longer password protected, so meeting minutes, reports, financial statements, audit reports, funding applications etc is visible to all comers. As we are a Charitable Trust there is no reason why this information should not be readily available <a href="https://braidedrivers.org/members/">https://braidedrivers.org/members/</a>
- **Facebook posts**: approximately 220 posts since the last meeting (see attached list). The most reached post was over 250,000 people...unfortunately that was a 'bad news' post about the 4X4s on the Ashley-Rakahuri that Grant Davely photographed.
- **2021 Braided Rivers symposium:** <u>https://braidedrivers.org/2021-seminar/</u> I will add a programme based on decisions made at the Friday 16 BRaid meeting. Currently, around 60% of places have been booked.
- **Opihi River:** Meeting with key stakeholders did not result in immediate further action to develop a community group, as none of the attendees were willing to take on a leadership role. Additionally, several people in ECan and DOC took on different roles post-Covid, so there has been a delay in what they can achieve. Tim Exton at DOC is part of the overarching Geraldine Tapping Alliance, and is aiming to progress potential volunteer trapping. Opuha Dam may have some funding for reducing weeds and habitat cration. BRaid will continue to offer support subject to the limits of our

resources.

- **Reports of bird counts** please see respective rivers or summary lists in newsletters
- **Rangiora High School** acknowledges a desire to continue with invertebrate monitoring but other priorities and the issues around education in 2020have set this programme back. Greater attention is now being focused on climate change, something I suggest we are likely to see from other schools.
